

# Symphonic Band Recording Project

**Objective:** Produce a quality recording of all 3 UIL pieces upon returning from February Conference Holidays.

**Assignment:** Record yourself with a metronome playing all 3 UIL pieces at the following tempos:

Broken Bow: QN = 120

Students will be given class time on Thursday and Friday, February 9th and 10th, to practice for their recording project. They may also use this time to record if they are able to bring their recording device to school.

This is a **MAJOR** assignment. Students will receive 4 separate grades for this assignment! The first grade will be a daily grade for turning in a playable recording in the correct format that is properly labeled with the student's name and instrument. The other 3 grades will be playing grades for the 3 recordings submitted. Playing grades will be based on rhythm/staying with the metronome, tone quality, correct phrasing, intonation, and articulation.
