# Trombone!

## **Models of Trombones Recommended by Band Directors:**

*These trombones hold up to normal wear and tear a 6<sup>th</sup> grade student puts an instrument through and make beautiful sounds:*

1. **Yamaha YSL 446G with F Attachment**
2. **Benge 165 F (comes with F Attachment)**
3. **Holton TR602 F (comes with F Attachment)**
4. **Getzen 700 Series with F Attachment**
5. **Bach 42 T or 42 BO with F Attachment**

*Following is the **only** mouthpiece we use. This is not the standard model that comes with the trombone. You will need to ask the company to switch them or you will need to buy it separately.*

**Mouthpiece: Schilke 51**

## **Trombone Supply List:**

*All supplies, as well as your child's trombone, will need to be brought to school on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of classes: August 24, 2011.*

Supplies you can find at all music companies:

1. Trombone cleaning kit
2. Spray water bottle (sometimes included in the cleaning kit)
3. Slide cream called "Trombotine"
4. Music stand for home practice (the best value is a folding, wire stand)
5. The "Korg TM-40" metronome and tuner combo
6. Band Textbooks

Supplies you can find at local stores:

1. 3-ring notebook (1 inch or ½ inch) of any color (they will need a black one in 7<sup>th</sup> grade)
2. Pencil pouch and several pencils
3. Mirror about the size of a locker mirror (versions with magnets on the back stay on the school stands easily)
